“Eleven as One”

Team Members: Membership is a privilege, which must be earned and maintained. Membership is not a right. Professionalism, responsibility, and respect will be maintained at all times.

PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES

1. You must act as a representative of this team, Coffee County High School, and your community AT ALL TIMES both in and out of school. Your actions and conduct reflect on those you represent.
2. All practices, meetings, film sessions and other official team activities are MANDATORY.
 - a. Unexcused absences = LAPS
 - b. Absence from school or practice the day before or the day of the game (without prior approval) means the player will not play in that game or scrimmage.
 - c. Late to any game, practice, or function = LAPS
3. ABSENCES
 - a. Notify Coach as soon as possible
 - b. Excused absences – church, required school functions, etc.
 - c. Job is NOT an excused absence – schedule accordingly now.
4. All running will be made up after school BEFORE PRACTICE, and must be completed prior to participation in any game.
5. Sportsmanship will be maintained at all times on and off the field.
 - a. YELLOW CARD: for dissention (talking back to the referee) = sit out remainder of the game. Depending on circumstances additional corrective action may be imposed.
 - b. RED CARD: For any reason. Player must leave the field and will be suspended for at least 2 additional games. A report must be filed with TSSAA and the player, his parents, and the Coach must meet with the Principal to decide what corrective action is appropriate and report back to TSSAA. Depending on the circumstances additional punishment may be imposed up to and including suspension from the team.
6. Fundraising – All players must participate. Parents are also expected to be involved.
7. Physicals – Required to practice and play. Yearly physicals expire May 1. Available at Physicians Medical Walk-In Care (1300 McArthur Dr), Walgreens, etc.

ACADEMICS

All players must comply with all rules set out by TSSAA governing enrollment, attendance, age, and residency of athletes and family. All players must pass the appropriate number of courses to maintain membership on the team. www.tssaa.org

*****All players must perform adequately in the classes they are taking DURING THE SEASON to participate in games or scrimmages. Negative reports from Teachers will result in corrective action by the Coach.*****

PROPER DRESS AND APPARELL

1. Players will dress and act in a PROFESSIONAL manner whether in school or out. (Your dress and actions reflect on the Team, your School, the Community, your Family, and the Coach)
2. No Jewelry (including earrings) is to be worn or displayed during any practice, game or team function.
3. No hats will be worn during any practice, meeting or team function.
4. Proper footwear must be worn at all times.
5. Game Day: Home game days the team will dress as directed by coach for that day (jersey, white shirt/tie/khakis, etc.). Away game days the team will wear away jersey. Failure to dress appropriately is a violation of team rules.

PERSONAL BEHAVIOR

1. NO SMOKING, NO DRINKING, NO CUTTING CLASS, NO CRIMINAL BEHAVIOR (including traffic violations), NO DISRESPECTFUL BEHAVIOR, NO SLEEPING IN CLASS.
2. NO DETENTIONS, NO IN SCHOOL SUSPENSION (ISD), AND NO OUT OF SCHOL SUSPENSION.
 - a. A player in ISD on game day is not eligible to play in that day's game
3. VIOLATIONS: Consequences for violation of these rules will depend on the circumstances of the offense, however you can help yourself if you notify the Coach before he hears it from anyone else.
 - a. If you notify the Coach – There will be a confidential meeting with the coaches to discuss the incident and corrective actions. If appropriate the coaches will notify the Administration and the player will be responsible for satisfying the requirements of the school as well as the team.
 - b. If the Coach hears it from someone else – The Player is immediately suspended from the team until the matter can be investigated and appropriate action taken.
 - c. FALIURE TO COMPLY WITH CORRECTIVE ACTION WILL RESULT IN DISMISSAL FROM THE TEAM.

MAKING THE TEAM

Player must meet a fitness criteria (e.g. 2 1/2 miles in 17 minutes, timed 110 yard runs, etc.).

EQUIPMENT: All players MUST have at EVERY practice **cleats, shin guards, a team practice shirt, and size 5 ball.** Players should dress appropriately for the weather. We will practice outside as much as possible. Players should dress for warmth. **Shin guards must have NOCSAE label (size associated w/ player's height)**

UNIFORMS: All players will be issued two uniforms (White and Red), Team Warm up (varsity), two practice shirts (additional shirts are available for \$4 each) and two pairs of socks. Team bags will be issued pending future fundraising. All items except the socks must be returned at the end of the season. Team attire is to be worn ONLY at Team functions or games, never for casual use.

JUNIOR VARSITY: These games are to help developing players get experience so they can assist the team when called upon.
